

User Guide for CS4 Premiere Pro

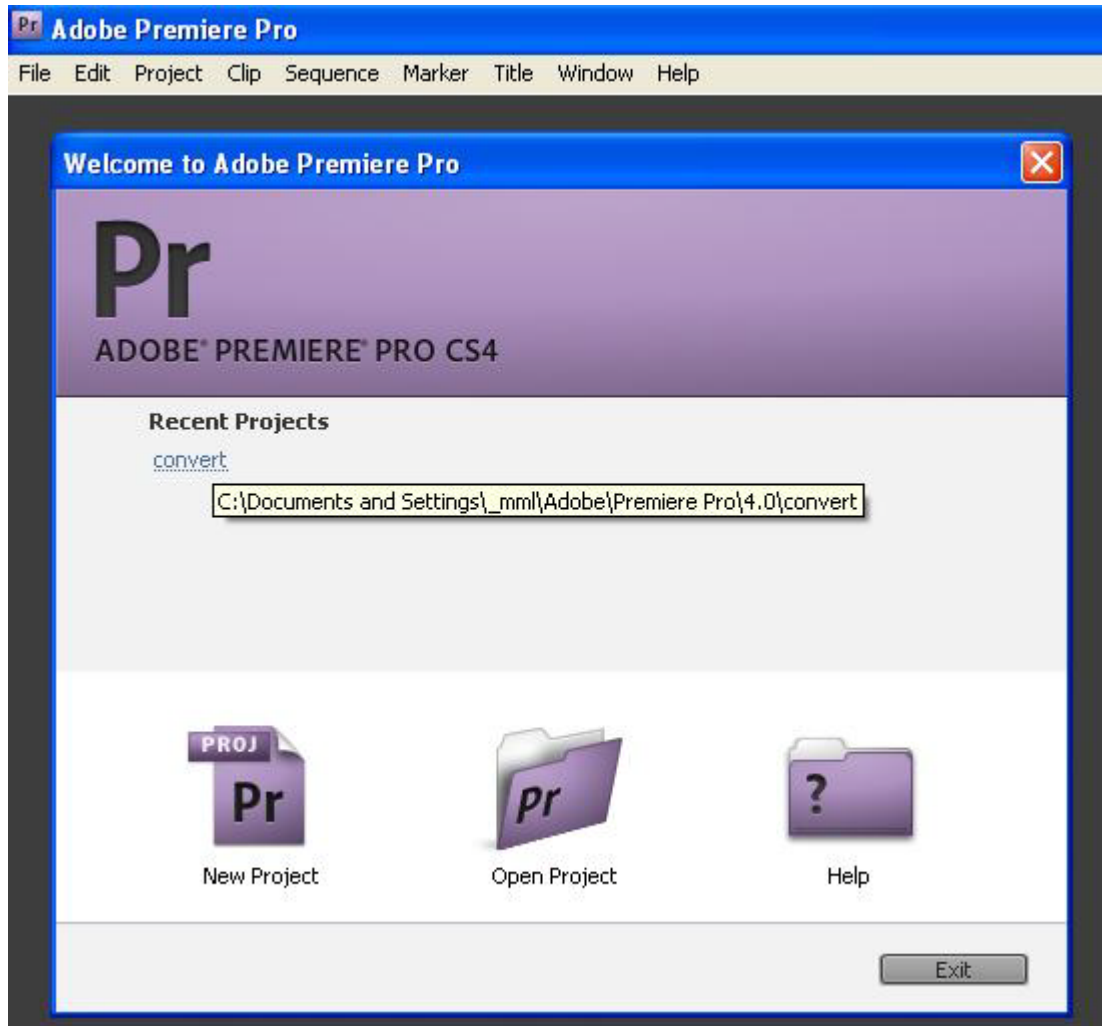
Note:

- ***You may want to connect all the necessary hardware to the system before you launch the application.***
- ***You may also use the default pop out windows to chose the application you want to use.***

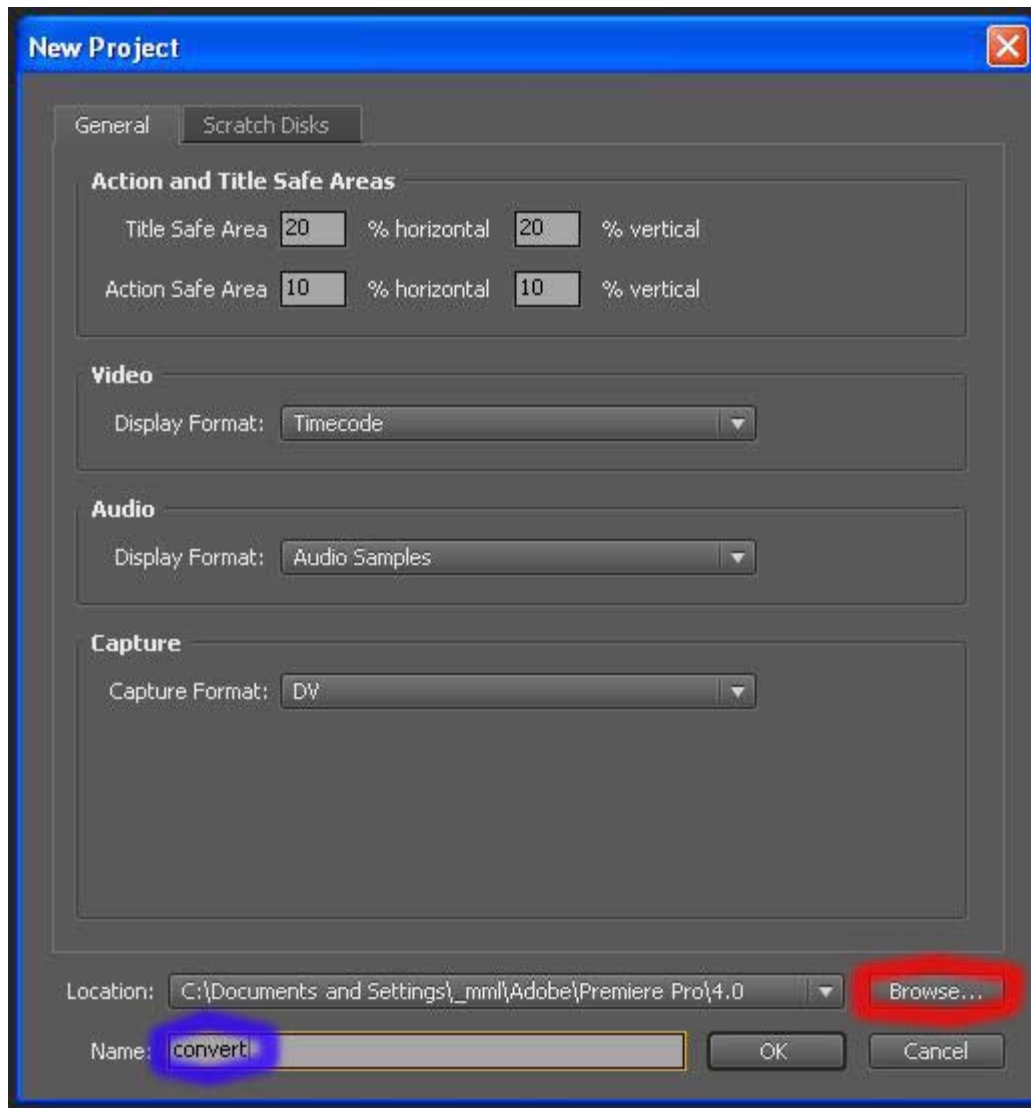
1. Double click on the CS4 premiere ICON, as shown in the picture below.



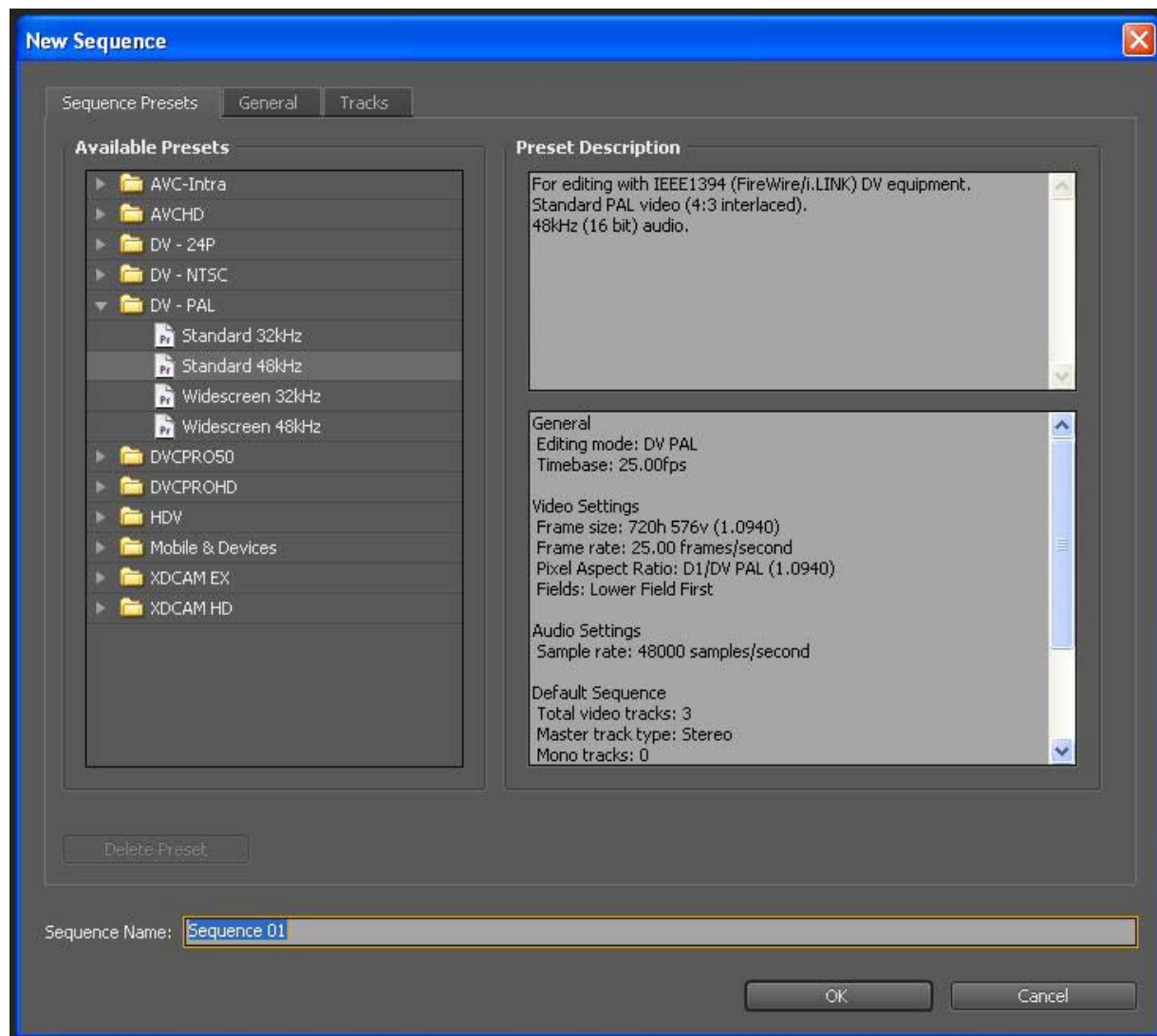
2. After CS4 premiere launched, you will see the window for you to choose to create a new project or use an existing project, as shown in the picture below.



3. Choose a new project, if you are creating new video conversion, but if you are adding to an existing project, just select the project that you have previously created.
4. If you create a new project, a window will prompt for you to choose the location and file name that you want for your project, as shown in the picture below.
5. You can click the browse button to select the location you want, as shown circle in red in the below picture.
6. Enter the name you desire in the "Name:" box, as shown circle in blue in the picture below.

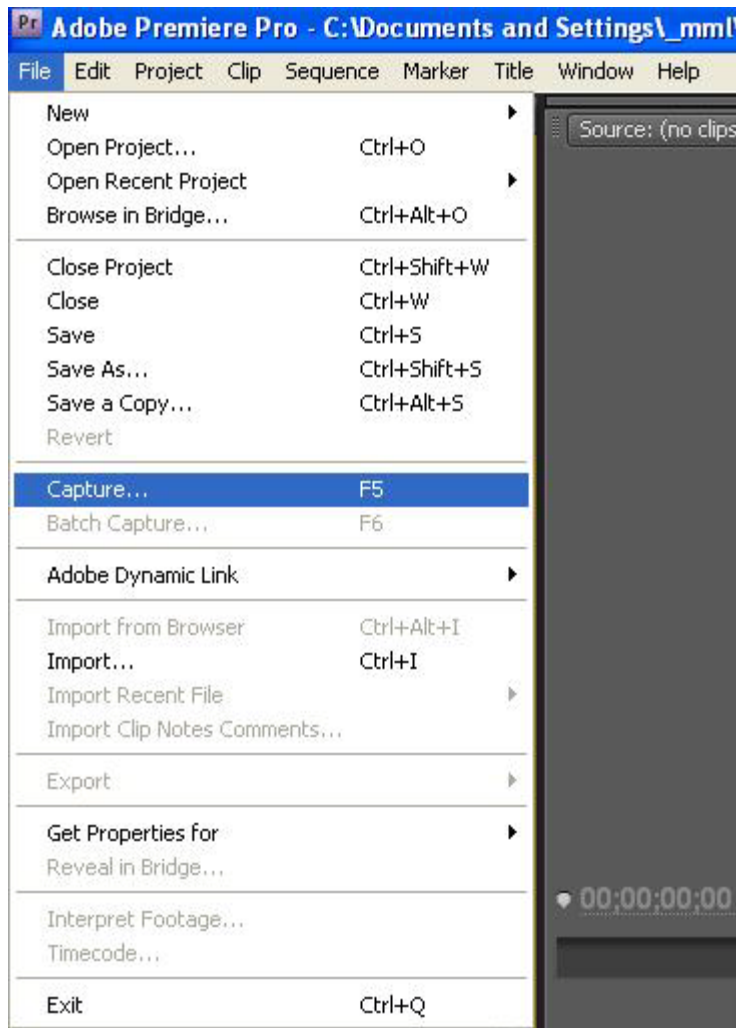


7. Click the “OK” button and the following window will prompt you to select the sequence and the video format that you want, as shown in the picture below.

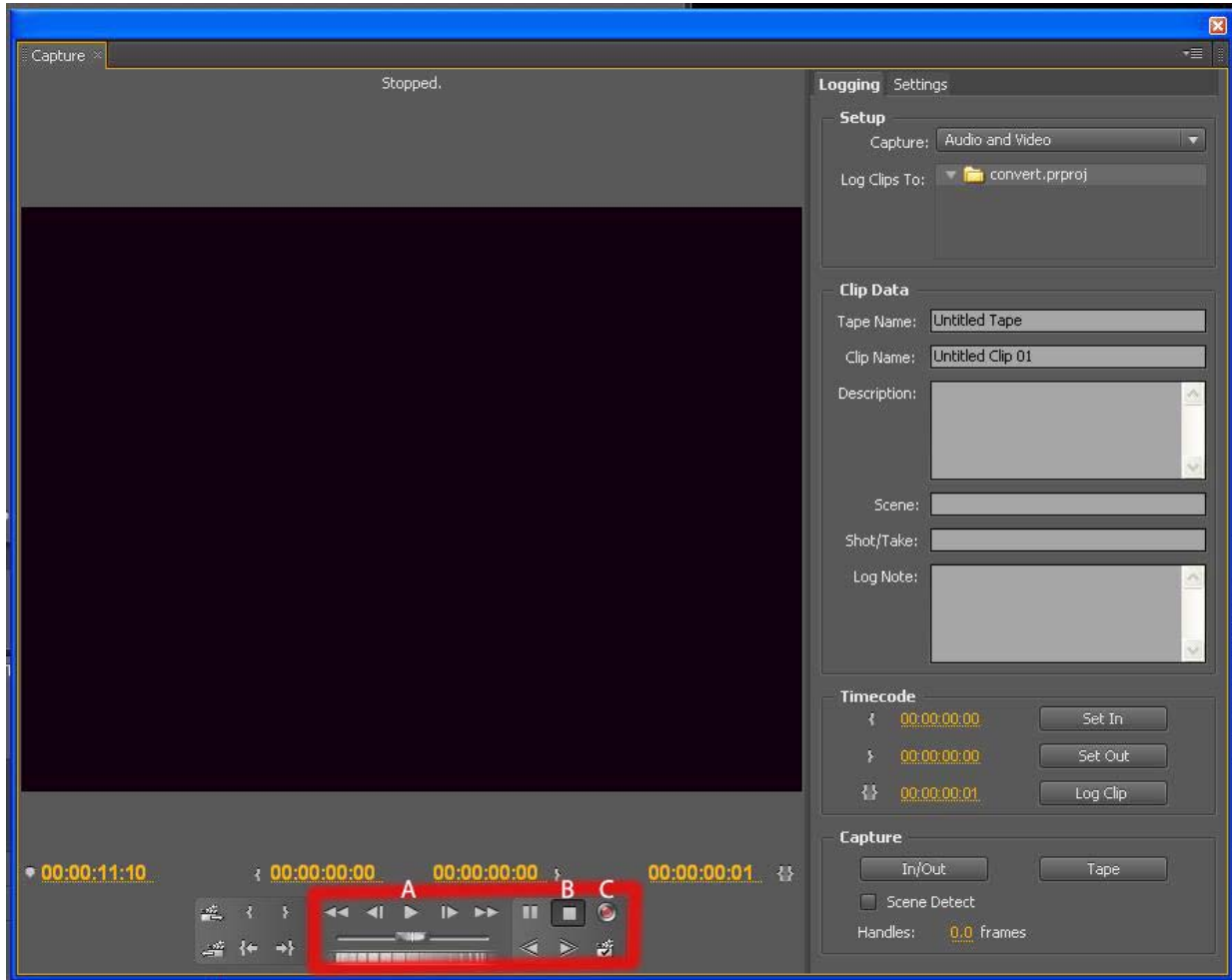


8. Choose the file format that you need and click “OK”
9. Note: Normal setting for singapore system should be DV-PAL, you can choose whatever format that you needed to use.

10. Before starting to capture any video, plugin the Camcorder into the firewire that is connected to the system.
11. You can also use the analog “RedYellowWhite” cable to connect to the system, to supply input from the VHS to the system.
12. To start the video capturing, click “File” at the left top hand corner and from the drop down list, select “capture”, as shown in the picture below.



13. An window will pop out as shown in the picture below.

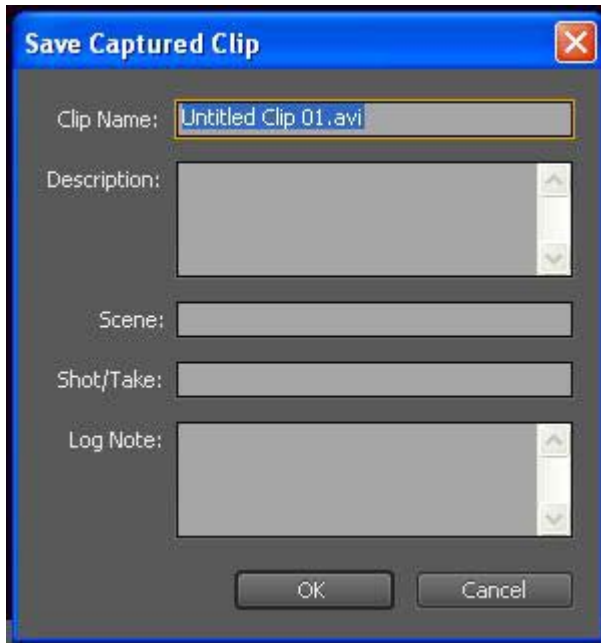


14. You can use the control as shown in the picture above circle in red.

15. Click "A" to play, "B" to stop and "C" to record the video that is playing.

16. So the procedure should be click "A" to play, follow by "C" to record, when the video end, click "B" to stop.

17. Once “B” is click to stop the recording, an window will pop out as shown in the below picture.



18. Enter the video name into the “Clip Name:” box, and click “OK”

19. The video will be in your project as shown in the picture below, double the file to start playing the video that you have just converted.
